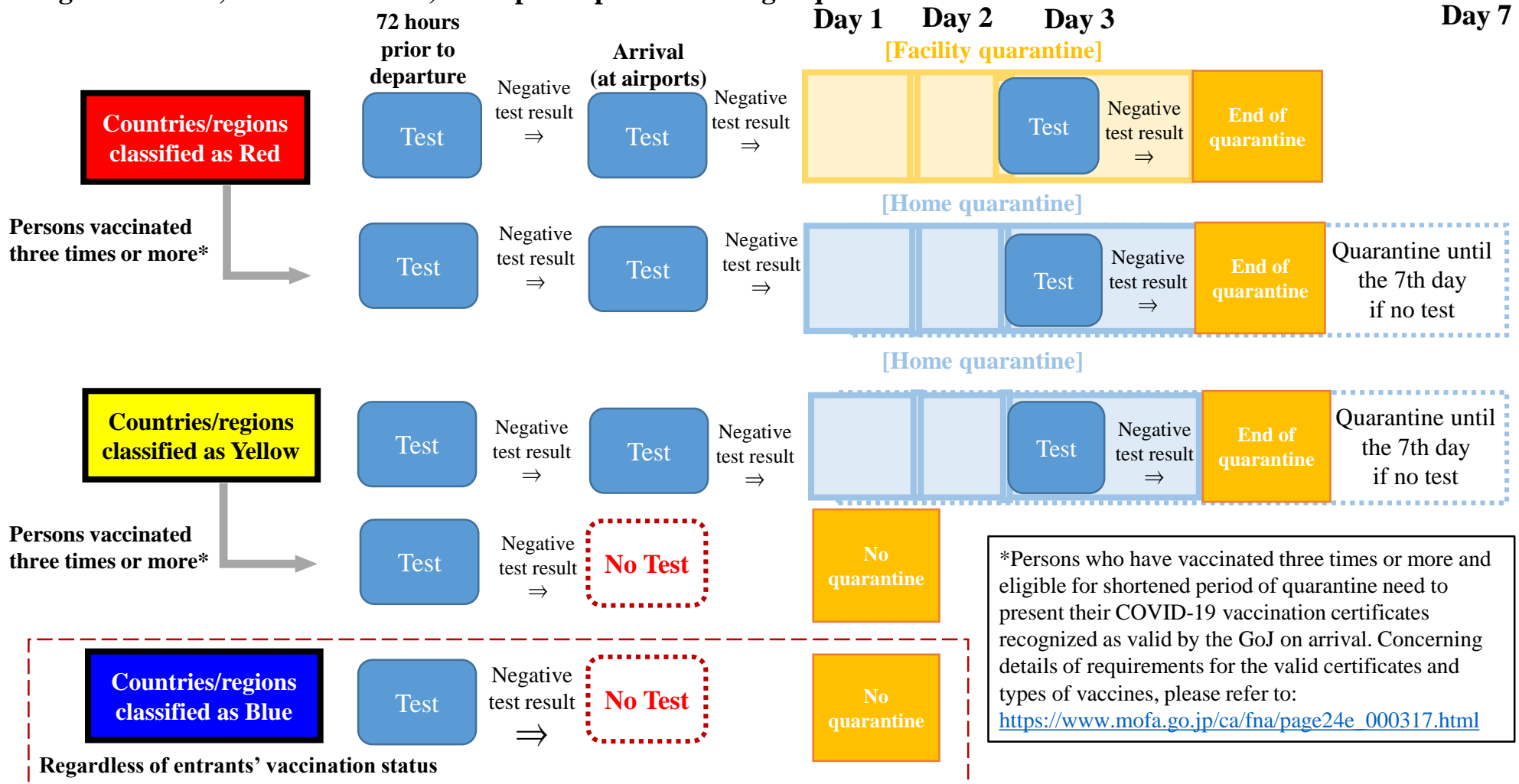


Japan's Reviewed Border Measures from June 1, 2022

- The Government of Japan (GoJ) will review requirements for entrants such as COVID-19 testing on arrival and quarantine period after entry into Japan, taking COVID-19 inflow risk from countries and regions into comprehensive consideration.
- The GoJ will increase the daily limit of the total number of entrants into Japan from about 10,000 to about 20,000.

◆ Starting from June 1, countries/regions where entrants have stayed before arriving Japan will be classified into three categories of Red, Yellow and Blue, while pre-departure testing requirements for all entrants remain the same.



*Persons who have vaccinated three times or more and eligible for shortened period of quarantine need to present their COVID-19 vaccination certificates recognized as valid by the GoJ on arrival.
