Japan's Reviewed Border Measures from June 1, 2022

- ➤ The Government of Japan (GoJ) will review requirements for entrants such as COVID-19 testing on arrival and quarantine period after entry into Japan, taking COVID-19 inflow risk from countries and regions into comprehensive consideration.
- > The GoJ will increase the daily limit of the total number of entrants into Japan from about 10,000 to about 20,000.
